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ACCOUNTING AND STATISTICAL NOTICE NO. 513

Procedures for Submitting Interim Summary Data

Rule 29.C. of CAR's Rules of Operation states that: "to determine the current premium Quota Share of a Newly Writing Company that becomes eligible for appointment as an Assigned Risk Carrier (ARC) pursuant to Rule 30 before that member is required to submit detailed statistical data under the provisions of the Massachusetts Private Passenger Automobile Statistical Plan, the Member is required to report interim summary data to CAR beginning no later than the 23-month anniversary of the calendar date on which the Member's initial Private Passenger Motor Vehicle Insurance rates and manual become effective. The Member will be required to report private passenger property damage liability car months of exposure by CAR identification code, policy effective month, premium town, classification, and merit rating status as defined in the Massachusetts Private Passenger Automobile Statistical Plan. The initial report will include the 12 consecutive policy effective months that will be used to determine the Member's initial Quota Share. Monthly data will be reported thereafter until the Member commences reporting detailed statistical data to CAR."

Accordingly, CAR has provided a secure area on its website for a Newly Writing Company to upload its interim summary data via an Excel spreadsheet. To upload the file, log on to www.commauto.com and select Reports then Data Transfers and under Interim Summary Data select Upload Data. On the next screen, select the company number, accounting date, and Browse to find the file. Move the filename into the designated box and select Upload. The Upload function will grab the file and load it to CAR's server. The filename must be named using the following format: cono_actgdate_type.xls as defined below.

- cono: represents the three-digit company number assigned by CAR for the ARC appointment
- actgdate: represents the monthly accounting data (in yyyyymm format) being submitted according to CAR's annual Call Schedule
- type: use a single character containing "o" for original submission or "r" for resubmission
- Example: 999_201006_o.xls

Because this is a secure link, each user will need a user ID and password to access the upload function. If you do not have a user ID and password, please contact your company's security administrator or CAR staff at dataoperations@commauto.com.

Within the Interim Summary Data function, there is a template available to identify the required data elements and to use for the data input if desired. All fields on the template are required and include:

The initial submission of Interim Summary Data must include all summarized premium data for the preceding 12 policy effective months from the date that the first Interim Summary Submission is due. The due date of the 1st submission is 23 months subsequent to the Effective Date of the ARC's rate filing. Please follow the example below to determine the Due Date for the initial Interim Summary Data submission and the policy effective date to include.

Effective Date of Rate Filing: June 1, 2008

05-01-2010	04-01-2009	03-31-2010	For the initial submission, the carrier must submit all summarized PDL exposure data as outlined in the template for policy effective dates April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010 and no later than May1, 2010.

Thereafter, the ARC must submit interim summary data monthly for the full 12 preceding policy effective months. That is, each interim summary submission will contain the 12 months of policy effective data to be included in the quota share calculation so that as one month ages beyond 12 months the new month is added to the summary. This monthly submission of the interim summary data must continue until the ARC begins full statistical reporting and must continue until the policy effective months have aged beyond the 12-month quota share cycle. Monthly submissions of interim data are due on the first of each month.

The examples below show the reporting requirements for the three months following the initial submission of interim summary data used in the example above.

08-01-2010	07-01-2009	06-30-2010	The fourth submission includes data for policy effective dates July 1, 2009 through – June 30, 2010 due by August 1, 2010.

When the ARC begins full statistical reporting, it has the option of reporting all detailed statistical data from its initial reporting data (April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010 using the example above) or starting with a specific period of time, for example August 1, 2010. If the ARC chooses to start at a specific period of time, it is still required to submit the interim summary data for the preceding rolling effective months until they have run off. Accordingly, for a period of time, the ARC will submit interim summary data in addition to detailed statistical data.

When reporting the interim summary data itself, please follow the guidelines as described below.

The summary data consists of private passenger property damage liability car months of exposure broken into subcategories of CAR ID Code, policy effective month, territory code, classification code and merit rating status. Please refer to the Massachusetts Private Passenger Statistical Plan for the coding requirements of these data elements. The data must be accumulated and summarized within each subcategory. The table below illustrates an example for policy effective months April and May.

To recap, the initial submission of interim summary data must contain all data summarized for the full preceding 12 consecutive months used to determine Quota Share. On the 1st of each month, thereafter, the ARC must submit the 12 policy effective months of summary data for the eligible period until full statistical reporting begins. CAR will provide a reporting schedule of the interim summary data in addition to the deadline for reporting full detail statistical records for each newly reporting company as part of its notification process following the 4th quarter submission of Annual Statement Page 14 data.
