Proposed Revisions to the Massachusetts Private Passenger Statistical Plan

CAR's Governing Committee, at its April 14, 2010 meeting, recommended modifications to the Massachusetts Private Passenger Statistical Plan. The recommended pages were forwarded to the Division of Insurance for promulgation pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 175A, §15. The following summary table describes the proposed modifications to the Private Passenger Statistical Plan and the proposed effective date.

August 1, 2010	In order to properly identify vehicles that are classified as Low Speed Vehicles, a new classification code has been added to the Private Passenger Statistical Plan. Appendix A - Classification Code Decision Table has been modified to identify those data elements that are required to be reported, not required to be reported or may be optionally reported on records coded with the Low Speed Vehicles classification code.
