ACCOUNTING AND STATISTICAL NOTICE NO. 532

2011 Statistical Edit Package and Classification Assignment Table

CAR has updated the Statistical Edit Package for policy year 2011 premium and loss reporting. The 2011 Classification Type Assignment Table is also available on CAR's website.

As announced in Accounting & Statistical Notice No. 519 dated April 27, 2010, the Division of Insurance promulgated revisions to the Private Passenger Statistical Plan relative to the classification of Low Speed Vehicles. As announced in Accounting & Statistical Notice No. 524 dated June 25, 2010, the Division of Insurance promulgated revisions to the Private Passenger Statistical Plan relative to the elimination of the Symbol Code on Private Passenger premium and loss records. The edit impact of these changes is reflected in the table below. In addition, there is a slight change to the S23 edit as it pertains to the Anti-Theft Discount Code on Commercial and Private Passenger Motorcycles and Low Speed Vehicles. The maximum discount amount allowed is 20%; therefore, the Anti-Theft Discount Code equal to 8 has been eliminated as an allowable code for these class types.

Edit	Change
S11 – OTC Coverage Code/OEM Cov. Code	Added classification code 0460XX (Low Speed Vehicles) as a valid class code for the OEM Coverage Code.
S12 – Collision Coverage Code/OEM Cov Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.
S15 – Annual Mileage Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.
S19 – Medical Payments Limit Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.
S21 – Age Code / Symbol Code / Model Year Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited. Also, for private passenger policies effective 1/1/2011 and subsequent, symbol code will no longer be edited.
S23 – Anti-Theft Device Disc Code	Modified the edit so that only Anti-Theft Discount Codes 0 and 4 are valid for Commercial and Private Passenger Motorcycles and Low Speed Vehicles.
S24 – Coverage Code / OEM Cov Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.
S28 – PIP Deductible Code / PIP Cov Code	For classification code 0460XX, allowed PIP Deductible Code of 01, 12-18, or 22-28.
S43 – Discount Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited and allow for Discount Code equal to 0, 1, 2, 4, A, B, C, or D.
S49 – Vehicle ID Number	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.

Edit	Change
S50 – Continuous Cov Discount Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.
S51 – Low Frequency Discount Code	Added classification code 0460XX to be edited.

As outlined in Accounting and Statistical Notice No. 518 dated April 16, 2010, the Governing Committee approved eliminating tape cartridges as a reporting method for statistical data as of the July 2011 accounting/statistical submission. Accordingly, any statistical submissions reported on a tape cartridge with an accounting date greater than June 2011 will be rejected. Beginning with the July 2011 accounting date submissions, FTP will be the only acceptable method for reporting statistical data to CAR. The manual data entry web application for the submission of small amounts of data will be maintained.

At its November 18, 2010 meeting, the Governing Committee approved the recommendation to perform the final closeout for policy effective year 1999 for reporting purposes as of the January 2011 submission. Under this procedure, companies may no longer statistically report paid and outstanding loss records for policy effective year 1999 as of the January 2011 monthly accounting/statistical submission. Accordingly, any effective year 1999 loss record reported in a 2011 submission will be considered a "fatal" error and deleted from the submission.
