## ACCOUNTING AND STATISTICAL NOTICE NO. 383

### 2003 Statistical Edit Package and Classification Assignment Table

CAR has updated the Statistical Edit Package and Class Assignment Table for policy year 2003 premium and loss reporting. These documents are available on the Manuals Page of CAR's website at [www.commauto.com](http://www.commauto.com).

As announced in Accounting and Statistical Notice No. 380, there are a number of edit changes due, in part, to the elimination of the Class Group Code and the Claim Count, new Liability Limits Codes, and a comprehensive review of the Statistical Edit Package as compared with the Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans. This notice details the changes specifically that apply to policies effective 1/1/2003 unless otherwise indicated. Also, please reference Accounting and Statistical Notice No. 374 for additional information.

<b>Edit</b>	<b>Change</b>
Class Code/CAR ID Code Agreement	Updated numbers '3a' and '4' to convert the CAR ID Code to a voluntary code rather than fatal the record.
Class Group	Class Group has been eliminated for policies effective 1/1/2003 and subsequent. CAR will ignore any value reported into that field.
S04 - Exposure	Class Code 661100 will now pass through this edit since Exposure is a required field.
S07 – BI Prem/Limits	There are new limits codes representing higher limits for both Private Passenger and Commercial business. For Private Passenger, BI, U1, and U2 limits of \$500,000 and above and Medical Payments limits of \$50,000 and above are not cedable to CAR. For Commercial, U1 and U2 limits of \$500,000 and above and Medical Payments limits of \$50,000 and above are not cedable to CAR.
S08 – PD Prem/Limits	There are new limits codes representing higher limits for both Private Passenger and Commercial business. For Private Passenger, PD limits of \$500,000 are not cedable to CAR. For Commercial, PD limits of \$750,000 and above are not cedable to CAR.
S09 – OTC Premium	Records with zero Exposure will now pass through this edit.
S10 – Coll. Premium	Records with zero Exposure will now pass through this edit.
S11 – OTC Coverage	Coverage Codes 060 and 063 are not valid for antique classes.
S12 – Coll. Coverage	Coverage Codes 041 and 092 are not valid for antique classes.

<b>Edit</b>	<b>Change</b>
S13 – Rating ID	A new Rating ID Code value of 0 has been added to indicate "No Experience Rated and Not All Other Rated Basis." Also, Gross Receipts and Mileage classes will now pass through this edit since Rating ID is a required field.
S14 – Exp Rating and All Other	Additional editing has been added for Rating ID Code 0.
S15 – Estimated Annual Mileage	Name change only to Annual Mileage Code.
S18 – Liability Limits Code	Please reference S07.
S19 – Medical Payments Limits	Class Code 793900 – Special Types – will no longer pass through this edit. Class Code 721600 – Special Types – will pass through this edit. Valid limit codes are spaces and 00-09. Class Code 053900 – Miscellaneous Rated as Private Passenger – will now have valid limit codes of spaces, 00, or 05-11. Class Code 796400 – Special Types – valid limit codes are spaces, 00, or 01. Class Code 946000 – Special Types – valid limit codes are spaces or 00-11. Medical Payments limits of \$10,000, \$15,000, \$20,000, and \$25,000 will be available for motorcycles as of 1/1/2003 policies. Limits codes of 06-09 have been added for motorcycles.
S22 – Pre-Insurance	Class Code 045200 – Special Types – will no longer pass through this edit.
S23 – Anti-Theft	Special Rating and Adjustment and Gross Receipts and Mileage classifications will no longer pass through this edit. Private Passenger and Commercial motorcycles will now pass through this edit - valid codes are 0 and 4.
S24 – Coverage Code	Coverage Codes 041, 060, 063, and 092 are not valid for antique autos.
S31 – Claim Count	Claim Count is not required for policies effective 2003 and subsequent so those records will no longer pass through this edit.
S36 – Liability Loss	New limit codes were added and the loss amount increased for some of the limit codes as of 2003.
S38 – Coverage/Type of Loss	For Coverage Code 041, Type of Loss 11 is invalid. For Coverage Code 217, Type of Loss 03 is invalid. For Coverage Codes 466 and 566, Type of Loss codes 03, 05, 06, 07, and 09 are invalid.
S40 – Trans Type	Added additional check for Type of Loss 23.
S44 – Partial/Total Ls	Transaction Code 25 records will now pass through this edit and must have a Total/Partial Loss Code of 2.
S45 – CAR ID Invalid for Producer Code	In order to eliminate confusion with the S46 – Producer Code edit, this edit will now compare just the CAR ID Code reported on the statistical record to CAR's Producer Code file.
S46 – Producer Code	Will match the Producer Code reported on the statistical record to CAR's Producer Code file on Producer Code number, Line of Business, and start and stop dates only.
V50 – Phys Dam Loss	The tolerance amounts have changed for certain coverage codes.
V51 – Allocated Loss	There are new limit codes added and tolerances amounts have changed for certain limit codes.
V52 – Prem and Exp	Some of the tolerances have increased.

At its November 20, 2002 meeting, the Governing Committee approved the Operations Committee recommendation to perform the final close-out for policy effective years 1990, 1991, and 1992 for reporting purposes as of the January 2003 submission. Under these procedures, companies may no longer statistically report paid and outstanding loss records for effective years 1990, 1991, and 1992 as of the January 2003 monthly accounting/statistical submission. Accordingly, any 1990, 1991, or 1992 effective date loss record reported in a 2003 submission will be considered a "fatal error" and deleted from the submission. Please reference Accounting and Statistical Notice No. 379 for more information.

Contained in the back pages of the Statistical Edit Package is the Reporting Requirements for submitting statistical data to CAR. CAR updated these requirements to include FTP transmissions and is expecting to begin accepting statistical submissions via FTP beginning some time in March 2003. Accordingly, CAR will notify the industry via a separate Accounting and Statistical Notice that will contain additional instructions and start dates for FTP statistical submission.
