Statistical Edit Change for 2003

As previously announced in Accounting and Statistical Notice No. 385, CAR recommended to the Governing Committee modifications to the Massachusetts Commercial Automobile Statistical Plan relative to the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002. The change to the Commercial Statistical Plan involves the addition of a one position field to all commercial premium records and the addition of new Type of Loss codes. CAR has updated its systems to accept and edit the new terrorism field, as well as display it on all relevant reports. CAR has also updated its Type of Loss Codes. CAR's Statistical Edit Package has been updated to reflect these edit changes and is available on CAR's Website at www.commauto.com.

Edit Name/Number	Description of Change
S54 - Terrorism Coverage Code	For policies effective 1/1/2003 through 6/30/2003, reporting of this coverage code is optional. For policies effective 7/1/2003 and subsequent, reporting is mandatory. However, companies that file a rate for terrorism coverage prior to 7/1/2003 are required to report this coverage code. The Terrorism Coverage Code is a one-position field and must have one of the following values: 1, 2, 3, 7, or 8. If the coverage code is 2, 3, 7, or 8, the CAR ID Code must equal 0 or 1.
S35 - Type of Loss Code	For policies effective 2003 and subsequent, Type of Loss codes 95, 96, 97, and 98 have been added. Type of Loss 95 and 97 are valid for sublines 615 and 618. And Type of Loss 95, 96, 97, and 98 are valid for subline 611.
