ACCOUNTING AND STATISTICAL NOTICE NO. 657

Approved Revisions to the Massachusetts Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans

Revisions to the Massachusetts Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans were approved by the Division of Insurance on December 16, 2020, pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 175A, § 15 (see attached). A summary of the Statistical Plan modifications and the approved effective dates are noted below.

The approved Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plan pages pertaining to the noted modifications are available on CAR's website. To view the approved pages, select Manuals, Private Passenger or Commercial Statistical Plan, and the 12/16/20 link under the Approved Pages heading.

Note that these modifications are mandatory for policies effective January 1, 2022 and subsequent, although companies may optionally commence reporting the modifications beginning with policies effective January 1, 2021. The approved modifications will be incorporated into the 2022 versions of the Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans which will be available on the Manuals page of CAR's website in the near future.
