BULLETIN NO. 1193

Revised MAIP Rate Pages for Policies Effective July 1, 2025

CAR Bulletin No. 1191, dated April 14, 2025, announced revised MAIP rates placed on file for policies effective July 1, 2025 and later. The rate pages published at that time showed basic limits rates calculated at the \$20,000/\$40,000 limit and provided Special Rating Instructions for calculating Parts 1 and 5 for the new compulsory limits. To enable Assigned Risk Companies to verify rating calculations, CAR has recalculated the rate pages for other than motorcycle classes to show basic limits rates calculated at the new \$25,000/\$50,000 bodily injury compulsory limits. The revised rate pages are now available on the MAIP Company and Producer pages of CAR's website under the Manuals tab.

Note that the base rates and rating factors included in schedule 107 remain unchanged at the \$20,000/\$40,000 limits. As notified in Bulletin Nos 1191 and 1189, Assigned Risk Carriers will use the Special Rating Instructions in the Implementation Notes to calculate Part 1 and Part 5 premiums.

Finally, please be advised that Rule 29 – Assignment Process of the CAR Rules of Operation details calculations for determining MAIP Quota Share and Assignment Order. The Rule currently contemplates the calculation of MAIP premium and credit premium, including subsidies, evaluated at \$20,000/\$40,000 limits. The Quota Share determination will remain as defined in the Rule until amendments are approved by CAR Committees and the Commissioner of Insurance. Relevant discussions will begin with the MAIP Steering Committee at its next meeting.
