CAR CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

Statement at Governing Committee and Advisory Committee Meetings

The CAR Governing Committee is, by statutory mandate, comprised of representatives of the very entities and persons participating in the residual market that it administers. Individuals serving on the CAR Governing Committee, its advisory committees, and/or its ad hoc committees must therefore be mindful of his or her obligation to act in the best interests of the Massachusetts automobile residual market and the motoring public.

A Committee Member who believes he or she has a conflict or potential conflict of interest should announce their recusal, refrain from otherwise participating in the discussion, and not cast a vote on the applicable issue.
